OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Mid- Career Interactions between Armed Forces and Civil Service Officers on the theme of "Cross Border Terrorism" is scheduled during 12-14 December, 2017 at AASC- Guwahati.

Department of Personnel and Training has been organising Mid-Career Interaction between the Armed Forces and Civil Services Officers in collaboration with the Ministry of Defence for the last many years. The basic objective of this programme is to provide exposure of IAS/IPS/IFoS and other civil officers to the military to meet unforeseen situations at short notice. Such interactions are likely to benefit both the Armed Forces and Civil Services officers by mutual learning from each other's strength and also by imbibing the best points of each other's work culture, ethos and customs. This, in the long run, is expected to help them to combat future challenges to national security in a better manner.

2. The Joint Civil-Military interaction courses are conducted at the tactical and operational levels. A detailed schedule has been worked out by the DoP&T, Training Division in consultation with Ministry of Defence for the various programmes to be conducted at the State/Centre Administrative Training Institutes and Armed Forces Organisations in various Regions of the country during 2017-18.

3. Department of Personnel & Training has proposed to conduct a **three days'** Mid- Career Interaction between the Armed Forces and Civil Services Officers on "**Cross Border Terrorism**" at **AASC- Guwahati** during **12-14 December, 2017**. Therefore, it is requested that **at least three (3) officers**, one each from IAS, IPS and IFoS (DM/ADM;SSP/SP/Addl. SP and DFO level), may kindly be deputed from the State for participating in the Programme.

4. These interactions have been very carefully planned with the active involvement of various organizations, hence, it is requested to depute suitable officers to participate in the programme and their telephone, mobile, fax, email details are shared with the nodal officer of the event and suitable joining instructions are served to the officer concerned. In case, officers from the All India Services are not available, kindly depute officers belonging to the State Civil Services (SCS) who are working at the cutting-edge level in the districts.
