NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan, in consultation with the High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan District Courts Ministerial Establishment Rules, 1986 namely :-

1. **Short title and commencement** :- (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan District Courts Ministerial Establishment (Amendment-) Rules, 2017.

(2) They shall come into force with immediate effect.

2. **Amendment in rule 7** :- After the existing rule 7C of the Rajasthan District Courts Ministerial Establishment Rules, 1986 hereinafter referred as said rules, the following new rule 7D shall be added, namely:-

“7D : Reservation of vacancies for Specially Abled Persons:-
Reservation for Specially Abled Persons in the recruitment and appointment shall be in accordance with the rules of the Government issued from time to time in this behalf :

Provided where the Appointing Authority is of the opinion that functions or certain jobs of the posts reserved in the Rajasthan persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Rules, 2011, as amended from time to time, can not be carried out by the persons with disabilities, the Appointing Authority may allow exemption from the operation of the reservation provided in the aforesaid rules subject to approval by the High Court.

Provided further that in the event of non-availability of eligible and suitable candidates in a particular year the vacancies so reserved for them shall be carried forward in the succeeding recruitment year and if in the succeeding recruitment year also suitable persons with disability is not available, it may be filled by interchange among the three categories and only when there is no person with disability available for the post in that year, the employer shall fill up the vacancy by appointment of a person, other than a person with disability."

3. **Amendment in rule-9** :- After the existing proviso (ix) to rule 9 of the said rules, the following new proviso (x) shall be added, namely:-


"(x) the upper age limit for the Specially Abled Persons shall be relaxed as under :-

- (i) 10 years for candidates belonging to General Category;
- (ii) 13 years for candidates belonging to Backward Classes; and
- (iii) 15 years for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes."

4. **Amendment in rule -19** :- After the existing proviso and before the Note of sub rule (i) of rule 19 of the said rules, the following new proviso shall be added, namely:-

"Provided further that relaxation of 5% marks in individual paper and in aggregate marks shall be provided to the candidates belonging to Specially Abled Persons."
