CIRCULAR.

M. F. B(2) Appts(A.III)/69. Dt. Jaipur, the 28th Oct., 1969.

Rule 15 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1958, specifies the Disciplinary Authorities for the various categories of the Government servants.

A doubt has been raised as to who will be the disciplinary authority for a Government servant who has been transferred from one department to another and against whom departmental proceedings are to be started for the delinquency done in the department from where he was transferred to the Department of the present posting.

It is, therefore, hereby clarified that in terms of provisions of Rule 15 of Rajasthan Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1958, the disciplinary authority for a Government servant permanently transferred to another department shall be the authority under whom the incumbent has been transferred irrespective of the fact whether the delinquency was committed in another Department prior to his transfer.

Cases of disciplinary proceedings against such officers, if any, pending with any department should be transferred to the Department where the delinquent officer/official has been posted or transferred permanently.
