C I R C U L A R

Sub:- Compulsory retirement under Rule 244(2)
of the R.S.R. of Government Servants
belonging to State Services.

..-

The existing provision e(ii) in this department's circular No.F.24(55)Apptt/A/57/Pt.I/Gr.I/CR dated the 19th June,1972 be substituted by the following :-

" The Government Servant proposed to be retired compulsorily under Rule 244(2) of the R.S.R. should normally be served with an order of retirement, as prescribed vide this department's circular No.F.8(52)Karmik/CR/72 Pt.II dated 3rd January,1973, accompanied with a bank draft of the amount equivalent to the three months pay and allowances, in lieu of notice period. In calculating this amount, the instructions contained in this department's circular No.F.8(52)Karmik/ACR/72/Pt.II/dated 17th Dec,1973 should be followed.

However, in exceptional circumstances, reasons for which should be recorded, if a Government Servant is proposed to be retired compulsorily under Rule 244(2) of the R.S.R. by giving him three months notice the required notice should be served on him. If during the notice period the

Government Servant Concerned applies for leave which may be due to him, he may be granted such leave subject to the condition that no leave may be granted for the period beyond the notice period."

This amended provision will come into effect immediately.
