Sub:- Compulsory retirement under Rule 244(2) of the  
R.S.R.-Employees of erstwhile State of Ajmer-  
Regarding.

Attention is invited to Finance Department Notification No.F.1(37)FD/Rules/72 dated 2.9.1975 substituting Rule 244 of R.S.R., whereby Government servants who have completed 20 years of qualifying service or have attained the age of 50 years can be retired compulsorily. In so far as the employees of the erstwhile State of Ajmer are concerned, approval of the Government of India under Section 115(7) of the States Reorganisation Act 1956 is required for the application of the new Rule 244 R.S.R. A reference has already been made to the Government of India and their approval is awaited. In this connection Department of Personnel's Circular No.F.1(104)Apptt/(C) 56-Part V dated the 25th May, 1973 may also please be referred to.

It is therefore requested that till the approval of the Government of India is received, no notices or final orders of compulsory retirement in respect of employees of erstwhile Ajmer State may be issued. A further communication will follow as soon as the approval of the Government
