Sub:- Compulsory retirement under Rule 244(2) of the Rajasthan Service Rules of MINISTERIAL STAFF in the Secretariat and other departments and offices of the Government.

Attention is invited to para 5 of this department's circular No.F.24(55)Appts/A/57/Pt.I/Gr.I/CR dated 19/26th April, 1972 on the above subject which is reproduced below:-

"On receipt of the recommendations of the Committee, retirement orders shall be issued immediately by the concerned Appointing Authority, as per specimen enclosed."

Government have reconsidered the above provision and it has been decided to substitute the same by the following:-

" On receipt of the recommendations of the Committee and consideration of the same, the appointing authority shall pass orders regarding the recommendations and where order of retirement is passed, it shall be on the lines of the specimen enclosed."
