C I R C U L A R

Sub:- Compulsory retirement under Rule 244(2)
of the Rajasthan Service Rules.

In continuation of circular of even number dated 13th Sept., 1985, the Government have decided to make a provision for appeal against the retirement orders under rule 244(2) passed by the appointing authority. As such any person who feels aggrieved of the order under rule 244(2) can make an appeal within seven days of the receipt of such order of retirement to the appellate Committee. The Appellate Committee in respect of Subordinate, Ministerial and Class IV servants shall consist of the following:

- i) Secretary in the Administrative Department. Convener
- ii) Special Secretary, DOP & AR (A-I)

In respect of Subordinate, Ministerial and Class IV servants in the Collectorates and Tehsils the committee shall consist of the following:

- i) Chairman, Board of Revenue.
- ii) Senior-most member of the Board of Revenue.

The committee shall look into the proceedings of the review committee and might call the record if it feels that there is a prima-facie case for consideration. In case the committee is satisfied that the orders passed for retirement under rule 244(2) are not in-conformity with the instructions and intentions of the Govt. or that excesses have been committed in enforcing the provisions out-lined under the instructions, the

committee may set aside the retirement orders.
