C I R C U L A R

Sub:- Compulsory retirement under rule 244(2) of the Rajasthan Service Rules.


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Attention is invited to the provisions of Rule 244(2) of the Rajasthan Service Rules which invest the Appointing Authority with the absolute right to retire in the public interest any Government Servant by giving him 3 months clear notice in writing or pay and allowances in lieu of such notice after completing of 25 year's qualifying service or attaining the age of 50 years or any date thereafter. The main purpose of this Rule is to enable Government to weed out, in the public interest, Government Servants whose efficiency is found to be impaired or integrity is considered doubtful.

Government have issued guidelines on the subject from time to time and these were also reiterated in the year 1985. However, it has been observed that sufficient importance has not been given to implementing these guidelines and instructions.

In its desire to tone up the administration and make it more responsive, the State Government attach great importance to this work and expect that each Administrative Secretary and Head of Department shall monitor and review the progress of work at their level and ensure strict compliance of these instructions.

All concerned authorities are accordingly again requested to ensure strict compliance keeping in view the time schedule & provisions as enunciated in the Circulars dated 23.4.90 & 25.5.90 issued in this regard.

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
