## **NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Educational Service Rules, 1970, namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement. (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Educational Service (Amendment) Rules, 2011.
- (2) They shall come into force with immediate effect.
- 2. Amendment of Part-IV. The existing Part-IV of the Rajasthan Educational Service Rules, 1970, hereinafter referred to as the said rules, shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

## "PART IV – Procedure for Direct Recruitment

- 16. Competitive Examination. All direct recruitments to the various posts in the service shall be made through a written competitive examination.
- 17. Authority for conducting the examination, syllabus and frequency of examination. (1) The examination shall be conducted by the Commission in accordance with the syllabus prescribed by the Government, from time to time.
- (2) Direct recruitment to the posts specified in the Schedules, shall be held at least once a year unless the Government decides that a direct recruitment for any of these posts shall not be held in any particular year.

18. Inviting of applications. - (1) Applications for direct recruitment to posts in the service shall be invited by the Commission by advertising vacancies to be filled, in the Official Gazette or in such other manner as may be deemed fit. The advertisement shall contain a clause that a candidate who accepts the assignment on the post being offered to him/her shall be paid monthly fixed remuneration at the rate fixed by the State Government from time to time during the period of probation and the scale of pay of the post as shown elsewhere in the advertisement shall be allowed only from the date of successful completion of probation mentioned in the recruitment rules:

Provided that while selecting candidates for the vacancies so advertised, the Commission may, if intimation of additional requirement not exceeding 50% of the advertised vacancies, is received by it before selection, also select suitable persons to meet such additional requirement.

- (2) Subject to the provisions of these rules, the Commission may issue, along with the notice or in such other manner as they may deem fit, such instructions for the guidance of the candidates as they may deem necessary, giving information among others on the following details:-
  - (i) Number of vacancies to be filled by direct recruitment, indicating the number of vacancies reserved for candidates of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes, Special Backward Classes, Economically Backward Classes, Women etc.;
  - (ii) Date of submission of applications for permission to appear at the examination and the method of submission;
  - (iii) Qualifications required for candidates and the methods by which these qualifications shall be established;
  - (iv) Date and place of examination;
  - (v) Syllabus of examination.

- 19. Form of Application and admission to the examination. -
- (1) The application shall be made in the Form prescribed by the Commission and obtainable from the Secretary to the Commission on payment of such fee, as the Commission may from time to time, prescribe.
- (2) No candidate shall be admitted to the examination unless he holds a certificate of admission granted by the Commission. Before granting such certificate the Commission shall satisfy themselves in each case that the application has been made strictly in accordance with the provisions of these rules.

Provided that the Commission may at their discretion allow any bona fide mistakes made in the filling of the prescribed form or presentation of the application to be rectified or any certificate or certificates not furnished with the application to be furnished in good time before the commencement of the examination.

- (3) The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility or otherwise of a candidate for admission to the examination shall be final.
- 20. Recommendations of the Commission. The Commission shall prepare a list of the candidates arranged in the order of merit on the basis of the marks obtained in the written competitive examination and forward the same to the appointing authority.

Provided that the Commission may also, to the extent of 50% of the advertised vacancies, keep names of suitable candidates on the reserve list. The Commission may, on requisition, recommend the names of such candidates, in order of merit, to the appointing authority within six months from the date on which the original list is forwarded by the Commission to the Government.

21. Disqualification for appointment. - (1) No male candidate who has more than one wife living shall be eligible for appointment to the service unless Government after being satisfied that there are special ground for doing so, exempt any candidate from the operation of this rule.

- (2) No female candidate who is married to a person having already a wife living shall be eligible for appointment to the service unless Government after being satisfied that there are special grounds for doing so, exempt any female candidate from the operation of this rule.
- (3) No married candidate shall be eligible for appointment to the Service, if he/she had at the time of his/her marriage accepted any dowry.

**Explanation:** For the purpose of this rule, 'dowry' has the same meaning as in the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 (Central Act 28 of 1961).

(4) No candidate shall be eligible for appointment to the service who has more than two children on or after 1-6-2002.

Provided that the candidate having more than two children shall not be deemed to be disqualified for appointment so long as the number of children he/she has on 1st June, 2002 does not increase.

Provided further that where a candidate has only one child from earlier delivery but more than one child are born out of a single subsequent delivery, the children so born shall be deemed to be one entity while counting the total number of children.

Provided also that this sub-rule shall not be applicable to the appointment of a widow to be made under the Rajasthan Compassionate Appointments of Dependents of Deceased Government Servants Rules, 1996.

Provided also that while counting the total number of children of a candidate, the child born from earlier delivery and having disability shall not be counted.

22. Selection by the appointing authority. — Subject to the provision of rule 7, 7A and 7B the appointing authority shall select candidates, who stand highest in order of merit in the list prepared by the Commission under rule 20:

Provided that the inclusion of a candidate's name in the list confers no right to appointment unless the appointing authority is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that such candidate is suitable in all other respects for appointment to the post concerned."

- 3. Amendment of Schedule I. In Schedule I appended to the said rules, under heading "Group F" the existing entries at item number 1(b) in column number 4 against serial number 1(a), 1(b), 1(c) and 1(d) shall be substituted by the following, namely:-
- "1(b) Minimum five years' teaching experience in any school."
- 4. Amendment of Schedule Schedule II. In Schedule II appended to the said rules, under heading "Group F" the existing entries at item number 1(b) in column number 4 against serial number 1(a), 1(b), 1(c) and 1(d) shall be substituted by the following, namely:-
- "1(b) Minimum five years' teaching experience in any school."
- 5. Amendment of Schedule III. In Schedule III appended to the said rules, under heading "Group F" the existing entries at item number 1(b) in column number 4 against serial number 1(i), 1(ii), 1(iii) and 1(iv) shall be substituted by the following, namely:-
- "1(b) Minimum five years' teaching experience in any school."
- 6. **Deletion of Schedule VII**. The existing Schedule VII of the said rules shall be deleted.
