Singapore Cooperation Programme

Singapore has provided technical assistance to other developing countries since the 1960s. As a country whose only resource is its people, Singapore believes that human resource development is vital for economic and social progress. Singapore itself has benefited from training provided by other countries and international organisations.

In 1992, the Singapore Cooperation Programme (SCP) was established to bring together under one framework the various technical assistance programmes offered by Singapore. Through the SCP, the range and number of training programmes were increased to share Singapore's development experience with other developing countries.

To date, over 137,000 officials from more than 180 countries and territories have participated in our courses and study visits. The SCP is managed by the Technical Cooperation Directorate of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Singapore.

Course Objectives

The COVID-19 pandemic has shown that cities and other urban areas are especially vulnerable to infectious disease outbreaks due to their high population density and connectivity. This course will present an overview of capacity building in urban health preparedness and share Singapore's experience in preparing and responding to outbreaks as a highly urbanised city-state.

Synopsis

Topics to be covered include:

- Singapore's experience in building national capacities and capabilities to respond to outbreaks at the global, national and local levels;
- Use of technology in urban health preparedness;
- Risk communication, community engagement and protection of vulnerable groups;
- Policy implementation at hospitals and primary care institutions; and
- Build community resilience and participatory governance for future outbreaks.



Methodology

This course will be delivered for up to <u>anticipants</u> through a mix of synchronous 'live' elearning sessions and asynchronous learning components. Synchronous components will include lectures, case studies, group discussions and presentations. Asynchronous components will include e-learning materials to complement the various Synchronous sessions.

Duration

The course will be held from 22 to 26 August 2022, from 1300 to 1700 hours (Singapore time; UTC +08:00 hours) each day. The actual timings of the synchronous e-learning sessions will be confirmed closer to the start of the course.

Application Information

Applicants should be:

- Mid- to Senior-level government officials from health ministries, health systems and other healthcare agencies;
- Able to attend all the synchronous e-learning sessions. They will require an internet-enabled device with webcam, microphone and audio features:
- Nominated by their respective Governments; and
- · Proficient in written and spoken English.

Terms of Award

The course is sponsored by the Government of Singapore under the Singapore Cooperation Programme Training Award.

Regulations

Participants are required to comply with the following:

- Strictly observe course schedules and not miss training sessions, and;
- Carry out instructions and abide by conditions as may be stipulated by the nominating Authority or Government and the Government of Singapore and its appointed trainer, with respect to the course.

Application Procedure

(Closing date for nomination: 29 July 2022)

The Government of Singapore is pleased to invite the respective National Focal Point for Technical Assistance (NFP) to nominate one (1) suitable applicant. Selection of candidates will be based on merit. Should there be more applicants than training places, the Government of Singapore seeks the understanding of the respective NFP in the event that its nominee(s) is not selected.

SUMMARY OF GUIDELINES PRESCRIBED BY DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AFFAIRS

Before applying for the training programme, the candidates are requested to satisfy themselves whether they fulfill the eligibility conditions as per the guidelines on Foreign Training Frogrammes (FTP) administered by the Department of Economic Affairs (DEA), summarized below:

Note: Project-related training/official visits abroad are exempt from the provision of cooling off.

Candidates and nominating authorities in Ministries/Departments/State Covts. etc. should also satisfy themselves about the eligibility conditions prescribed by the sponsoring foreign Government/agency before sending the neminations to DEA.

HOW TO APPLY

- 3. Filling up of application forms:-
- Ensure that the DEA proforma is duly filled in and is complete in all respects. Without this proforma, applications will not be entertained.
- (ii) Ensure that the application form prescribed by the sponsoring agency is also complete in all respects. Wherever the sponsoring agency asks for Country Report, the same should also be attached.
- (iii) The column relating to Vigilance Clearance in DEA proforms should be filled in and certified by the competent authority. Alternately, vigilance clearance certificate by the concerned authority can also be attached. Applications without vigilance clearance at the time of applying will not be entertained.
- (iv) In case of training programmes which are not fully spensored and where expenses on Air travel or any other expenses have to be borne by the candidate or his spensoring Department, ensure that Part-A or Part-B, as the case may be, of the Undertaking Form is duly completed. Applications received without undertaking form will be summarily rejected. It may be noted that submission of undertaking form is not necessary in respect of fully funded training programmes and the candidate can mention 'Not Applicable' in the form.

4. Nominations:

- In case there is more than one nomination for a particular course, the nominating authority State/Central Government should clearly indicate the prioritization of the nominees.
- (ii) Application for the training programme is to be forwarded through the concerned Ministry/Department after completing all necessary formalities. Applications are not to be sent to the sponsoring foreign country/ agency direct unless the same has been endorsed by the Nodal Department i.e. DEA.

5. Clearances:-

Once the nomination forwarded by DEA to the sponsoring foreign Government is accepted and conveyed to the applicant, he/she will be responsible to complete all pre-departure formalities like obtaining political clearance from MEA and have the sanction order issued from his/her administrative Department etc.
