## Singapore Cooperation Programme

Singapore has provided technical assistance to other developing countries since the 1960s. As a country whose only resource is its people, Singapore believes that human resource development is vital for economic and social progress. Singapore itself has benefited from training provided by other countries and international organisations.

In 1992, the Singapore Cooperation Programme (SCP) was established to bring together under one framework the various technical assistance programmes offered by Singapore. Through the SCP, the range and number of training programmes were increased to share Singapore's development experience with other developing countries.

To date, close to 150,000 officials from more than 180 countries, territories and intergovernmental organisations have participated in our courses and study visits. The SCP is managed by the Technical Cooperation Directorate of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Singapore.

#### Course Objectives

This course will examine Singapore's Digital Economy framework, from strategy to action and how it is enabled by Big Data and Analytics. Participants will learn how to design, innovate and deliver programmes that provide digitally enabled citizen services, promote businesses and enhance the quality of citizens' lives.

## Synopsis

Topics to be covered include:

- Singapore's approach to the regulation and promotion of the digital economy and ecosystem
- Data sovereignty and residency in the digital economy
- International issues and cooperation in the development of the digital economy
- Future trends and emerging technologies in the digital economy and currency

## Methodology

This course will be delivered for up to 30 participants through synchronous e-Learning ('live' e-learning sessions) on Zoom, and could include asynchronous e-Learning (independent and self-study e.g. reading materials). There will be Q&A sessions and facilitated group discussions during the 'live' sessions.

### Regulations

Participants are required to comply with the following:

- Strictly observe course schedules and not miss training sessions, and;
- Carry out instructions and abide by conditions as may be stipulated by the nominating Authority or Government and the Government of Singapore and its appointed trainer, with respect to the course.





### Duration

The course will be held over 5 days from 12 to 16 December 2022.

## **Application Information**

Applicants should be:

Mid- to senior- level government officials involved in developing the digital economy in their country.

## Terms of Award

The Government of Singapore will be responsible for training fees.

## **Application Procedure**

Selection of candidates will be based on merit. #### HOW TO APPLY

- Filling up of application forms:-
- Ensure that the DEA preferma is duly filled in and is complete in all respects. Without this proforma, (i) applications will not be entertained.
- Ensure that the application form prescribed by the sponsoring agency is also complete in all respects. (ii) Wherever the sponsoring agency asks for Country Report, the same should also be attached.
- The column relating to Vigilance Clearance in DEA proforms should be filled in and certified by the (iii) competent authority. Alternately, vigilance clearance certificate by the concerned authority can also be attached. Applications without vigilance clearance at the time of applying will not be entertained.
- In case of training programmes which are not fully sponsored and where expenses on Air travel or any (iv) other expenses have to be borne by the candidate or his sponsoring Department, ensure that Part-A or Part-B. as the case may be, of the Undertaking Form is duly completed. Applications received without undertaking form will be summarily rejected. It may be noted that submission of undertaking form is not necessary in respect of fully funded training programmes and the candidate can mention 'Not Applicable' in the form.
- Nominations:-4.
- In case there is more than one nomination for a particular course, the nominating authority State/Cenral (1) Government should clearly indicate the prioritization of the nominees.
- Application for the training programme is to be forwarded through the concerned Ministry/Department after (ii) completing all necessary formalities. Applications are not to be sent to the sponsoring foreign country/ agency direct unless the same has been endorsed by the Nodal Department i.e. DEA.
- Clearances:-

Once the nomination forwarded by DEA to the sponsoring foreign Government is accepted and conveyed to the applicant, he/she will be responsible to complete all pre-departure formalities like obtaining political clearance from MEA and have the sanction order issued from his/her administrative Department etc.
