In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules for regulating the recruitment of out of turn appointment to Sports Medal Winners of the Rajasthan, namely:-

- **1. Short title and commencement.-** (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan out of turn appointment to Sports Medal Winners Rules, 2017.
 - (2) They shall come into force with immediate effect.
- **2. Scope.-** Notwithstanding anything contained in any service rules regulating the recruitment of persons in various services of the State or in the rules that may be framed hereinafter, the Sports Medal Winners of the Rajasthan shall be eligible for appointment to the posts specified in Schedule 1, II and III appended to these rules.
- 3. Criteria and manner for out of turn appointment to Sports Medal Winners.*
 (1) The appointment to sports Medal Winners shall be made in accordance with the following criteria:-
 - (i) Category A

Medal Winner in Olympic Games (Summer)/Paralympic Games;

Or

Medal Winner in World Cup/World Championship/Para World Cup/Para World Championship;

Or

Medal Winner in Asian Games/Asian Para Games;

Or

Medal Winner in Commonwealth Games/Commonwealth Games Para Events:

Or

Winner/Runners up of Cricket World Cup/Championship;

Or

Winner/Runners up of Polo World Cup/Championship, shall be considered for appointment to the posts specified in Schedule I.

(a) Medal Winners of Olympic Games,

(a) Silver and Bronze Medal Winners of Asian games (Asiad)/Commonwealth Games,

(a) Medal Winners (Senior) in National games,

⁽b) Gold medal Winners of Asian games (Asiad)/Commonwealth Games, shall be considered for appointment to the posts specified in Schedule I.

⁽ii) Category B

⁽b) Winners and runners up of World cup / (World championship in sports which are recognized in Rajasthan sports act or are included in Olympics/ Asian games (Asiad)),

⁽c) Medal Winners or Winners / runners up in Asian Athletics championship / Commonwealth Games in sports mentioned above,

⁽d) Medal Winners of Para Olympics, shall be considered for appointments to the posts in grade pay 3600/- or above specified in Schedule II

⁽iii) Category C

⁽b) Medal Winners or Winners/runners up in above sports in National Championship (Senior),

shall be considered for appointment to the posts in grade pay less than Rs. 3600/- specified in Schedule II and to the posts specified in Schedule III.

Explanation: The above Games/Championships/Cups should be recognized by the concerned International Association/Body/Federation for the games. "vide Notification No. F. 15(3)DOP/A-II/2013/pt. dated 18.03.2020.

Medal Winner of Asian Championship/Asian Para Championship;

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Medal Winner of South Asian Games/South Asian Para Games;

Winner/ Runners up of Cricket Asia Cup/Championship,

shall be considered for appointment to the posts of Level in Pay Matrix L-10 or above specified in Schedule II.

(iii) Category C

Medal Winner in National Games/National Para Games;

Or

Medal Winner in National Championship / Para National Championship;

Or

Winner/Runners up in National Championship of Polo;

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Winner/Runners up of Ranji Trophy,

shall be considered for appointment to the posts below Level in Pay Matrix L-10 specified in Schedule II and to the posts specified in Schedule III.

- ¹(2) For the purpose of appointment under these rules, only sports achievements obtained by the players on or after 01/01/2016 shall be considered. Medal Winner sportsperson shall have to apply to the Secretary, Sports and Youth Affairs Department within three years from the date of winning the medal or within one year from the date of commencement of the Rajasthan out of turn appointment to Sports Medal Winners (Amendment) Rules, 2020. The Sportsperson shall mention the priority of posts applied as mentioned in concerned category of these rules in his application;
- (3) Appointment under these rules shall be given to eligible sports persons of the State of Rajasthan only.
- (4) Medal Winners who are appointed under these rules shall be encouraged and provided enabling environment to continue playing and achieving high goals in their respective sports for at least five years and during this period their performance assessment will be linked to their sporting achievements. These players will also be made available to the Sports and Youth Affairs Department for participation, training or supervision of tournaments as required.
- (5) The eligible Medal Winners shall be appointed on different category posts which are vacant or by deemed creation of new posts in the required category by the concerned department. These new posts shall be in addition to the regular cadre strength. The eligible Medal Winners who join a department on a particular category of posts shall be exempted from the requisite professional qualifications and shall be required to complete special courses/professional courses prescribed by the department in a given time frame.
- (6) The educational qualifications required for the post under the relevant service rules shall not be insisted upon at the time of appointment and in such cases, conditional appointment may be given but the sportsperson shall have to acquire the requisite qualifications within the period of five years failing which the appointment shall be terminated.
- ²(7) The minimum and maximum age limit shall be according to the concerned service rules.
- (8) The appointments to Medal Winners to different posts under these rules shall be made on the recommendation of a Committee consisting of the Chief Secretary as chairperson, Secretary-in-charge of the Home Department as a member, One Secretary to the Government of any Administrative Department nominated by the Chief Secretary as a Member and Principal Secretary Sports and Youth Affairs Department as Member-Secretary. The recommendation of the committee shall be processed and submitted to the Government for approval by the Sports and Youth Affairs Department.

- *(8A) A medal winner of any category mentioned in sub- rule (1), who is a resident of the State of Rajasthan and already serving under the Central Government or any other State Government shall be considered for appointment in the State, if he is otherwise eligible for appointment under these rules, on any equivalent post mentioned in Schedule-II or Schedule-III, as the case may be, irrespective of his/her eligibility for appointment under sub-rule (1). On such appointment his/her pay and pay level shall be protected in respect of the pay he/she was drawing in the Central Government or in any other State Government, subject to maximum pay of the pay level in which appointment is made.
- (9) The Committee shall call the sportsperson and ask for his desired post and then offer the post according to his achievement.
- ¹(10) The seniority of the persons appointed under these rules shall be determined from the date of their appointment on the post after regular selection in accordance with the provisions of these rules. The inter-se seniority of the persons appointed under these rules on the same date shall be determined in the following order:-

(a)	Gold Medal Winner of Olympic Games. (Summer)
(b)	Gold Medal Winner of Paralympic Games.
(c)	Silver Medal Winner of Olympic Games. (Summer)
(d)	Silver Medal Winner of Paralympic Games.
(e)	Bronze Medal Winner of Olympic Games. (Summer)
(f)	Bronze Medal Winner of Paralympic Games.
(g)	Gold Medal Winner of World cup/Championship.
(h)	Winner of Cricket/Polo World cup/Championship.
(i)	Gold Medal Winner of Para World Cup/Para World Championship.
(j)	Silver Medal Winner of Para World cup/World championship.
(k)	Runners up of Cricket/Polo World Cup/Championship.

If two or more Medal Winner have the same medal in the same championship, the seniority shall be determined on the basis of their age and the older shall be considered to be senior. In case of same age, seniority shall be determined according to the English alphabetical order of their names.

¹4. Physical fitness.- A sportsperson to be appointed under these rules must be in a good mental, physical and bodily health and free from any mental defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of his duties as a member of the service provided sportsperson must fulfill the health parameters like height, chest, eye-sight etc. if they are required in concerned service rules for the post opted by the sportsperson belonging to any category. But in case a Medal Winner of Para Sports to be appointed under these rules must be in a good mental health and free form any mental defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of his duties as member of the service provide Medal Winner of Para Sports must fulfill the health parameters like height, chest, eye-sight etc. if they are required in concerned service rules for the post opted by the sportsperson belonging to any category. The selected sportsperson of both the category must produce a certificate to the effect from a Medical Authority notified by the Government for the purpose.

5. Application of relevant service rules.- Except as provided in these rules, the appointment under these rules shall be regulated by the relevant service rules;
