NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Civil Services (Special Selection and Conditions of Service of Project Directors, Chief Executive Officers, Additional Chief Executive Officers, Additional District Programme Coordinator (EGS), Executive Engineers and Project Officers) Rules, 1975, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Civil Services (Special Selection and Conditions of Service of Project Directors, Chief Executive Officers, Additional Chief Executive Officers, Additional District Programme Coordinator (EGS), Executive Engineers and Project Officers)(Amendment) Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 01.01.2017.

2. Amendment of Schedule-II.- In Schedule-II appended to the Rajasthan Civil Services (Special Selection and Conditions of Service of Project Directors, Chief Executive Officers, Additional Chief Executive Officers, Additional District Programme Coordinator (EGS), Executive Engineers and Project Officers) Rules, 1975, the existing condition 1 and 2 and entries thereto shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

"1. **Scale of Pay.-** On appointment to the post mentioned in Schedule-I, the Officer / Official shall draw the same pay, which he / she was drawing immediately before appointment (in the substantive or officiating capacity) in the Pay Level in the Pay Matrix under the Rajasthan Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2017 prescribed for the existing post. The next date of increment shall remain unchanged.

2. **Special Allowance.-** All officers appointed on the posts mentioned in column 2 of Schedule-I, shall be paid special allowance at the rate of 7% of the basic pay drawn in the Pay Level in the Pay Matrix under the Rajasthan Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2017 during their tenure in the Rural Development and Panchayati Raj Department.

Exception: The officiating pay for the purpose of this rule shall mean pay drawn in officiating capacity in the existing post after regular recruitment and shall not include pay drawn on ad-hoc or urgent temporary basis or on account of leave vacancy or purely as a temporary basis."
