NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Educational (State and Subordinate) Services Rules, 2021, namely:-

**1. Short title and commencement.-** (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Educational (State and Subordinate) Services (First Amendment) Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Amendment of rule 31.-** In rule 31 of the Rajasthan Educational (State and Subordinate) Services Rules, 2021, hereinafter referred to as the said rules,-

(i) in item (b),-

(a) for the existing expression, "Member", against serial number 4, the expression "Member Secretary" shall be substituted; and

(b) the existing serial number 5 and entries thereto shall be deleted;

(ii) the existing item (c) and entries thereto shall be renumbered as item (d);

(iii) after item (b), so amended and before item (d), so renumbered, the following new item (c) shall be inserted, namely:-

"(c) for the post(s), appointments whereto are to be made by the Joint Director of the range concerned, falling within the purview of the Commission:

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| 1. Chairman of the Commission or a member thereof nominated by him.   | Chairman         |
| 2. Joint Secretary/Deputy Secretary to the Government in the Department of Education.   | Member           |
| 3. Nominee of the Secretary-in-charge to the Government in the Department of Personnel, not below the rank of Deputy Secretary to the Government. | Member           |
| 4. Nominee of Director, Secondary Education, not below the rank of Joint Director.  | Member           |
| 5. Joint Director, School Education of the range concerned  | Member Secretary |

" and

(iv) in item (d), so renumbered, for the existing expression, "Secondary Education", against serial number 1, the expression "School Education" shall be substituted.

**3. Amendment of rule 32.-** The existing clause (iv) of proviso to sub-rule (4) of rule 32 of the said rules shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

"(iv) any candidate who performed remarriage which is not against any law and before such remarriage he is not disqualified for promotion under this sub-rule, he shall not be deemed to be disqualified with effect from 01.06.2002, if any child is born out of single delivery from such remarriage."

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4. **Amendment of rule 36.-** The existing clause (7) of proviso to rule 36 of the said rules shall be substituted by the following, namely, -

"(7) the person who gets transferred on his/her own request to another range /district/appointing authority from the former range/district/appointing authority shall be placed below the junior most person already appointed to this post by the later range/district/appointing authority and he/she shall have no right regarding seniority in the former range/district/appointing authority from where he/she has been transferred."

5. **Amendment of Schedule-I.-** In Schedule-I appended to the said rules,-

(1) under the heading Group-A: Administrative wing,-

(i) the existing entries of column number 7, against serial number 5, shall be substituted by the following, namely, -

"Post graduate and B.Ed. or equivalent examination recognized by the NCTE with 3 years' experience on the post mentioned in column number 6.";

(ii) after the existing item number 3 and entries thereto, in column number 8 against serial number 5, the following new item number 4 and entries thereto shall be added, namely:-

"4. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, as a one time measure the Government may provide upto 100% relaxation in the required experience for the year 2023-24, if the eligible and suitable persons for promotion are not available"; and

(iii) in column number 7, against serial number 6, for the existing expression, " by UGC" the expression "by the NCTE" shall be substituted.

(2) under heading Group B : Teaching wing, -

(i) the existing serial number 1 and entries thereto shall be substituted by the following, namely :-

(iii) in column number 8, against serial number 2 for the existing expression, "Senior Teachers" the expression "Senior Teacher (General)" shall be substituted;

(iv) in column number 6, against serial number 3, for the existing expression, "Senior Teacher", the expression "Senior Teacher (General)" shall be substituted;

(v) in column number 8, against serial number 3, for the existing expression "Senior Teachers", the expression "Senior Teacher (General)" shall be substituted;

(vi) the existing serial number 4 and entries thereto shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

4.	Lecturer (Drawing)	100%	-	Post Graduate or Equivalent examination recognized by UGC in Drawing or the qualification declared equivalent thereto by the Government or Diploma of four/ five years' duration in Arts from any school / College of Arts recognized by the Government.	Senior Teacher (General)	Graduate or Equivalent examination recognized by UGC in Drawing or the qualification declared equivalent thereto by the Government with 5 years experience on the post mentioned in column 6 or Higher Secondary/ Secondary with optional Drawing or the qualification declared equivalent thereto by the Government with 10 years experience including 5 years' on the post mentioned in column 6.	Till the Senior Teacher (General), who have qualification as mentioned in column number 7 are exhausted, the post shall be filled 50% by direct recruitment and 50% by promotion.
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(vii) the existing serial number 5 and entries thereto shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

Lecturer (Agriculture)	100%	-	Four years Bachelor degree in Agriculture / Horticulture from any university recognized by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research / State Government and Post Graduate in relevant subjects of Agriculture / Horticulture from any university recognized by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research/ State Government with Degree or Diploma in Education recognized by the National Council for Teacher Education/Government.	Senior Teacher (General)	Four years Bachelor degree in Agriculture / Horticulture from any university recognized by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research / State Government and Post Graduate in relevant subjects of Agriculture / Horticulture from any university recognized by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research / State Government with Degree or Diploma in Education recognized by the National Council for Teacher Education /Government with 5 years' experience on the post mentioned in column 6. 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- (viii) in column number 6, against serial number 6, for the existing expression "Senior Teacher", the expression "1. Senior Teacher 2. Senior Teacher (Special Education)" shall be substituted;
- (ix) in column number 8, against serial number 6, for the existing punctuation mark "-", the expression "A candidate who has obtained degree of Post Graduation in subject other than Graduate level before 03.08.2021, shall also be considered for promotion." shall substituted;
- (x) after the existing serial number 6, so amended, the following new serial number 7 and 8 and entries thereto shall be added, namely:-

(3) under heading Group D : Physical Education wing, in column number 5, against serial number 5, for the existing expression "term", the expression, "term/time" shall be substituted.

**6. Amendment of Schedule-II.**— In schedule-II appended to the said rules, under heading 'Group-A: Teaching wing,-

- (i) in column number 6, against serial number 1, after the existing expression "2. Laboratory Assistant", the expression "3. Teacher (Special Education)" shall be added;
- (ii) in column number 6, against serial number 3, for the existing expression "3. Teacher in Blind School/Deaf and Dumb School", the expression "3. Teacher (Special Education)" shall be substituted;

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- (iii) in column number 2, against serial number 6, for the existing expression "Teacher in Blind/Deaf & Dumb School", the expression "Teacher (Special Education)" shall be substituted.
- (iv) in column number 5, against serial number 7, for the existing expression "and", the punctuation mark "," shall be substituted.
7. **Amendment of Schedule-III.**- In Schedule- III appended to the said rules,-
- (1) under the heading 3. Scheme and syllabus of examination for the post of School Lecturer, in serial number 6,-
- (i) in item number 5 of Paper-I General Studies, for the existing expression "Educational Management", the expression "Educational Psychology, Educational Management" shall be substituted; and
- (ii) in item number 4 of Paper-II Subject concerned, the existing expression "Educational Psychology," shall be deleted;
- (2) under the heading, 5. Scheme and syllabus of competitive examination for the posts of Senior Teacher",-
- (i) in serial number 6 of Paper-I, the existing expression "for each paper" shall be deleted; and
- (ii) in serial number 5 of Paper-II, the existing expression "for each paper" shall be deleted;
- (3) under the heading "6. Scheme and syllabus of competitive examination for the posts Lecturer of Physical Education, Senior Physical Education Teacher and Physical Education Teacher", in serial number 6 of Paper-I, the existing expression "for each paper" shall be deleted;
- (4) under the heading, 8. Scheme and syllabus of competitive examination for the post of Librarian Grade-II & Grade-III,-
- (i) in serial number 5 of Paper-I, the existing expression "for each paper" shall be deleted;
- (ii) in serial number 5 of Paper-II, the existing expression "for each paper" shall be deleted;
- (iii) in serial number 6 of Paper-II,-
- (a) under the item (ii), for the existing expression "Standard course of cataloging.", the expression "Standard code of cataloging." shall be substituted;
- (b) under the item (iii), the existing expression "General Knowledge of world and India." shall be deleted;
- (c) under the item (iii), for the existing expression "CC, EDC, UDC", the expression "CC, DDC, UDC" shall be substituted; and
- (d) under item (iv), the existing expression "Educational Psychology" shall be deleted.
- (5) under the heading, 9. Scheme and syllabus of competitive examination for the post of Laboratory Assistant,-
- (i) in serial number 5 of Paper-I, the existing expression "for each paper" shall be deleted;
- (ii) in serial number 5 of Paper-II, the existing expression "for each paper" shall be deleted.
- (6) under the heading 10. Scheme and syllabus of competitive examination for the posts of Senior Computer Instructor,-
- (i) after the existing serial number 5 and entries thereto and before the heading Syllabus and Scope of Papers of Paper-I, the following serial number 6 and entries thereto shall be inserted, namely:-
- "6. The minimum qualifying marks shall be 40%. Provided that the percentage fixed as above shall be relaxed by 5% for the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes."
- (ii) the existing serial number 5 of the Paper-II shall be renumbered as serial number 6; and
- (iii) after the existing serial number 4 and entries thereto and before the serial number, so renumbered, the following new serial number 5 and entries thereto shall be inserted, namely:-

"5. The minimum qualifying marks shall be 40%. Provided that the percentage fixed as above shall be relaxed by 5% for the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes."

(7) under the heading, 11. Scheme and syllabus of competitive examination for the posts of Basic Computer Instructor,-

(i) the existing serial number 4, 5 and 6 of the Paper-I shall be renumbered as serial number 5, 6 and 7 respectively; and

(ii) after the existing serial number 3 and entries thereto and before the serial number 5 so renumbered, the following new serial number 4 and entries thereto shall be inserted, namely:-

"4. The minimum qualifying marks shall be 40%. Provided that the percentage fixed as above shall be relaxed by 5% for the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes."

(iii) the existing serial number 5 of the Paper-II shall be renumbered as serial number 6; and

(iv) after the existing serial number 4 and entries thereto and before the serial number 6, so renumbered, the following new serial number 5 and entries thereto shall be inserted, namely :-

"5. The minimum qualifying marks shall be 40%. Provided that the percentage fixed as above shall be relaxed by 5% for the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes."

(8) after the existing heading 11 and entries thereto, the following new heading 12 and entries thereto shall be added, namely :-

"12. Scheme and syllabus of competitive examination for the post of Lecturer (Special Education):-

(1) The examination shall carry 450 marks.

(2) There shall be two papers. Paper I shall be of 150 marks and Paper II shall be of 300 marks. The duration of Paper I shall be one and a half hours and the duration of Paper II shall be three hours.

(3) All the questions in both papers shall be Multiple Choice Type.

(4) The minimum qualifying marks shall be 40%. Provided that the percentage fixed as above shall be relaxed by 5% for the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.

(5) Negative marking shall be applicable in the evaluation of answers. For every wrong answer, one third of the marks prescribed for that particular question shall be deducted.

**Explanation:** Wrong answer shall mean an incorrect answer or multiple answers.

(6) Subjects included in both the papers are given hereunder.

**Syllabus and Scope of Papers:-** The syllabus and scope of paper for the examination shall be as prescribed by the Commission, from time to time and shall be intimated to the candidates within the stipulated time in the manner as the Commission deems fit.

### Paper – I : General Studies

Duration: 1:30 hours

#### SUBJECTS

1. History of Rajasthan and Indian history with special emphasis on Indian National Movement.
2. Mental Ability Test, Statistics (Secondary level), Mathematics (Secondary level), Language Hindi and English ability test.
3. Current Affairs.
4. General Science, Indian Polity, Geography of Rajasthan.

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5. Educational Psychology, Educational Management, Educational Scenario in Rajasthan and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act.

**Paper – II Subjects and Special Education**

Duration: 3 hours


**SUBJECTS**

1. **Knowledge of Senior Secondary Level of subjects** viz. English, Hindi, History, Political Science, Sociology, Music.
2. **Special Education:-** Agencies, policies, acts and rules regarding specially abled persons and special education. Pedagogy, Teaching Learning Material, Use of Computers and Information Technology in Teaching Learning. Education for the specially abled students with various kinds of disabilities.
