NOTIFICATION


In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Legal (State and Subordinate) Service Rules, 1981, namely:-

**1. Short title and commencement.-** (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Legal (State and Subordinate) Service (Amendment) Rules, 2025.  
(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 23.07.2003.

**2. Amendment of rule 28.-** The existing sub-rule (8) of rule 28 of the Rajasthan Legal (State and Subordinate) Service Rules, 1981 shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

"(8) A Committee consisting of the Chairman of the Commission or a Member thereof nominated by him as Chairman, the Principal Secretary/Secretary to the Government in the Department of Personnel or his representative not below the rank of the Deputy Secretary to the Government as member and the Principal Secretary to the Government in the Law and Legal Affairs Department or any officer nominated by him not below the rank of Special Secretary to the Government, Law and Legal Affairs Department as Member-Secretary, shall consider the cases of all the senior most persons who are eligible and qualified for promotion to the class of post concerned under these rules and shall prepare a list containing names of the persons found suitable on the basis of seniority-cum-merit or on the basis of merit, as the case may be, as per the criteria for promotion laid down in these rules equal to the number of vacancies determined under these rules. The list so prepared on the basis of seniority-cum-merit and/or on the basis of merit, as the case may be, shall be arranged in the order of seniority of the category of post from which selection is made."
