2. As per the RRs (copy enclosed), the post is to be filled amongst the following officers on deputation:

(I) Officers of All India Services or Central Civil Services Group 'A':-

(a) (i) holding analogous post on a regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or (ii) with two years of regular service in Level 13A (Rs. 131100-216600) in the Pay Matrix in the parent cadre or department; or (iii) with three years of regular service in Level 13 (Rs. 123100-215900) of the Pay Matrix in the parent cadre or department;

(b) Possessing the following educational qualification and experience, namely:-

3. The eligibility conditions for the post of Controller, BARC, are mentioned in **Annexure-A**.

4. In case of deputation, it shall be governed by the terms and conditions stipulated in the DoPT O.M. No. 6/8/2009-Estt. (Pay-II) dated 17.06.2010 as amended from time to time.

5. The period of deputation shall be for 05 years and further extendable as per the guidelines of DoPT OM No. 6/8/2009-Estt. (pay-II) dated 17.6.2010 & OM No. 2/6/2018-Estt (Pay-II) dated 18.5.2018, subject to further requirement and performance of the Officer.

6. In order to reward the performance of an organization within Department of Atomic Energy and the role of the personnel in realizing its objectives, Performance Related Incentive Scheme (PRIS) is introduced which is the variable component of the pay and is awarded on the basis of the performance of the individual/group/organization measured against set goals, during the period of assessment. Accordingly, the selected Officer will be eligible to get the PRIS amount based on his performance and other components like APAR gradings, attendance and vigilance clearance.

7. The application of willing and eligible officers, who have completed cooling off period of 3 years since last deputation (if applicable), and have undergone more than 1 deputation prior to this and who can be spared immediately, if selected, may be forwarded along with the following documents so as to reach the Deputy Secretary (Cadre), Department of Atomic Energy, Anushakti Bhavan, CSM Marg, Mumbai - 400 001, latest by 27.03.2025.

DEPARTMENT OF ATOMIC ENERGY**NOTIFICATION**

Mumbai, the 20th February, 2025

G.S.R. 143(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Department of Atomic Energy (Controller, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre) Recruitment Rules, 2013, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Controller, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre in the Department of Atomic Energy, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Department of Atomic Energy (Controller, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre) Recruitment Rules, 2025.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and level in pay matrix.- The number of the said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. – The method of recruitment to the said post, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living;

or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt such person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, other Backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
