Accordingly, the matter has been duly considered in this Department and it has been decided with the approval of the Competent Authority to extend the existing timelines for recording PAR for the year 2024-25 by 01 month, in relaxation of Rule5(1) read with Schedule 2 of AIS (PAR) Rules and 7A so as to give sufficient time to each authority, as indicated below: -
